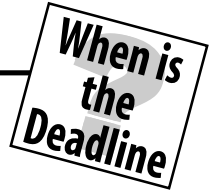


Call For Entries: grades 6-12

- Artwork:** color or black & white photo, photocopy, or digital file (submit@studentbylines.com) of your original work. Image will be printed in black & white (line art or grayscale) except for the artwork selected for the cover of the book (full color).
